The following corrections should be noted:

### 1 **Montserrat**

The Volcanic Activity Exclusion Zones have been extended to 2 miles offshore between Roche's Bluff and Spanish Point and the W coast zone extended northwards to Old Road Bay 2 miles offshore (ILNW 92/07)

### 2 **Little Bay, Montserrat**

Insert drying wreck sym and lgd *Wk* in 16°48'·1N 62°12'·4W (ILNW 248/07)

### 3 **Saba, Fort Baai (Chart & Plan A)**

Insert Lts:

F.G *PA* in 17°36'·98N 63°15'·12W

F.R *PA* in 17°36'·94N 63°15'·09W. (ILNW 495/07)

### 4 **Saba, Diamantrots**

Insert Lt Q in 17°38'·84N 63°15'·37W (ILNW 495/07)

### 5 **Saba, Fort Baai southeastwards**

Delete Y mooring buoy in 17°36'·68N 63°14'·86W (ILNW 461/08)

### 6 **St Christopher (St Kitts), west coast**

Fortress Marine are reported to have established a hauling facility 165t travel lift, with storage area ashore, in approx. position 17°20'·2N 62°50'·11W (below Brimstone Hill). (ILNW 169/09)

### 7 **Nevis**

Customs and Immigration have become very strict. Mariners are advised not to go ashore, and to keep the quarantine flag flying, until clearance has been obtained. (ILNW 170/09)

### 8 **Basseterre, Port Zante (Plan C)**

The marina at Port Zante is repeatedly subject to a 'washing machine problem' - i.e. surge can build up inside the marina. If the wind is south of east, mariners are advised to check with the marina via radio before entering. (ILNW 171/09)

### 9 **Charlestown (Plan E)**

Moorings have been established north of the pier in Charlestown. Mariners are advised to use this mooring, as anchoring is reportedly not allowed. (ILNW 172/09)

### 10 **Basseterre Bay, Port Zante Marina (Plan C)**

The marina breakwater has reportedly been extended to the west. Berths inside the marina will accommodate boats to 70'. Outside, along the north side of the breakwater, is a berth to accommodate boats to 225', draft unknown.

Surveys carried out by the Netherlands Government in recent years have revealed depths different to those charted in Fort Baai.

Insert mooring buoy in 17°36'·74N 63°14'·90W. (ILNW 112/10)

Delete *Obstr* sym in 17°36'·95N 63°15'·56W (ILNW 113/10)

**15 Oranje Baai (Plan B)**

Delete anchorage sym in 17°28'·78N 62°59'·27W (ILNW 114/10)

**16 Saba**

Delete mooring buoy in 17°36'·75N 63°14'·90W (ILNW 468/10)

**17 St Eustatius southeastwards**

Delete DW Wk in 17°27'·58N 62°54'·60W, plus assoc W can Lt buoy Q close N. (ILNW 144/11)

**18 Oranje Baai (Plan B)**

Insert G pillar buoy in 17°28'·68N 62°59'·32W (ILNW 208/11)
